The U.S. Department of Education has made additional Emergency Financial support to students of our institution for their expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to Coronavirus. This represents the 3rd round of funding since the pandemic began. This application permits students to apply for these funds. Campus administration will use the information you provide to determine your eligibility and the amount for which you will be awarded. Awards will be prioritized to students demonstrating exceptional need based on PELL eligibility, FAFSA information and other factors. All students will receive at least \$500.00.

Dear Students:

The U.S. Department of Education has made additional Emergency Financial support to students of our institution related to the disruption of campus operations due to the continued pandemic. The funding package provides additional aid to cover components of cost of attendance and emergency costs. PTC recently received an additional funding authorization to begin distributing these additional funds.

PLEASE NOTE: This is a completely separate application for additional funding from the one produced back on March 4th that you received if you were eligible.

In order to be eligible as in the prior application, students must be actively enrolled or on an approved leave of absence at the time of completing the application. Funding will be prioritized to students demonstrating exceptional need based on PELL eligibility, FAFSA information and EFC (Expected Family Contribution). All students will receive at least \$500.00. Please allow 1-2 weeks from the time of the processing of your application for funds to be distributed.

To make this application process as easy as possible for PTC students, a form will be added to your Dashboard for completion.

If you are experiencing problems in logging in or locating the form, please contact Jayme Holloway at Holloway.Jayme@ptcollege.edu.

Additionally, if you or your family's financial situation has changed significantly from what is reflected on your federal income tax return (for example, if you've lost a job or otherwise experienced a reduction in income), you may be eligible to have your financial aid adjusted. FAFSA completion is required for this review. Please contact the Office of Student Financial Services to obtain the necessary forms or for more information at financialaid@ptcollege.edu or by contacting the school. Please note that the school's decision is final and cannot be appealed to the US Department of Education.
