- We operate our PN Program in clock hours so transcripts will reflect hours, not credits
- Our quarters are 12 weeks in length
- Transfer students will need to purchase the current PN textbooks, uniforms, the full ATI package and IPAD through our bookstore
- Based on the above transfer credit reference, a student may be scheduled on a part time basis, following our quarterly sequencing
- Students should be informed that not all of their earned credits, grades and/or hours will be accepted for transfer
- If the student transcript shows a final letter grade of C or better, those classes will be accepted as outlined above; however, if the student transcript shows a final grade in percentage, the final grade must be 77% or higher to be considered passing for our PN program
- There may be additional items for consideration that may arise in the future and will be communicated with PTC administration if this should occur
