Hourly rates will vary based on the establishment and employee experience. ****Total percentage includes only those programs that offer an internship. *****Applicable programs only. PTC's Nursing, Practical Nursing, and Therapeutic Massage graduates must pass a licensure exam to be employed in their field of study. Due to regulatory requirements, graduates awaiting licensure are not available to receive career search assistance until licensure is granted.

One statistic for Oil and Gas was adjusted on 5/22/2019. This resulted in the "Full-Time", and "Full-Time, Part-Time, and Freelance" employment rates changing from 100% to 90%.
